As part of our **International Data Science Accelerator Programme**, we now offer **International Data Science Mentor Clinics** – sessions organised to brief, present and detail how mentoring internationally works and answer all questions from those interested in being part of this collaboration experience.

The sessions are an hour long and will involve:

- a brief presentation on the current International Data Science Accelerator cohort with examples of the type of projects supported by the programme;
- a panel of 3-4 international mentors to share their experience and answer any questions;
- a couple of mentees to share their experiences;
- the International Accelerator coordinators team to ensure all logistical, administrative and support questions are being answered.

This is an endeavour to encourage more data scientists, analysts and statisticians to step forward and apply to be mentors in our future International Data Science Accelerator Programme cohorts. After running two sessions of our programme we discovered there is a lot of international interest from mentees who put forward really exciting projects, but not enough involvement from professionals who would qualify as mentors.

The International Mentor Clinics aim to clarify, encourage and support a stronger international collaboration in the data science field.
